Private Insurance/CHIPS/Medicaid/Private Pay

- Many local pharmacies offer required immunizations. Call each for details on vaccine availability, insurance, pricing, etc.
- Local Health Departments will often give required Immunizations as private pay but will not bill insurance.

CHIPS/Medicaid/Uninsured/Underinsured

CHIP and Medicaid are accepted. Uninsured or underinsured fees are based on a sliding scale. Acomplete shot record is required for all children's immunizations; a school note alone will not be accepted. Call to verify schedules.
