ABOUT OUR SCHOOL

In the fall of 1981, Plano East Senior High School was opened with 563 juniors. At present, the approximate enrollment at Plano East is 3100 juniors and seniors. An additional 415 9th and 10th graders are enrolled in the IB World School. Plano East has a long history of academic excellence and provides innovative programs that meet the needs of a diverse population.

ABOUT OUR COMMUNITY AND DISTRICT

Located 20 miles north of Dallas, the Plano Independent School District includes three senior high schools (11-12), six high schools (9-10), thirteen middle schools (6-8) and forty four elementary schools (K-5). The district enrollment is approximately 48,000 students.

CURRICULUM

Over 250 courses are offered to students at Plano East Senior High, allowing students to design a program which specifically meets their unique talents and needs as individuals.

HEALTH SCIENCES ACADEMY

The Health Sciences Academy began at our feeder high school in 2013 with 150 9th and 10th graders. There are currently 141 students in the program at Plano East and an overall total of 328 in HSA. A collaboration with Collin College and Williams High School, the academy provides state of the art training through dual credit courses.

**INTERNATIONAL BACCALAUREATE
WORLD SCHOOL**

The International Baccalaureate Program is a rigorous course of study designed to meet the needs of highly motivated students. Certified as an IB school in July 1995, the Plano East IB program includes a total of approximately 695 students in the 11th and 12th grade IB program and 9th and 10th grade Pre-IB prep program. All students admitted to the Plano East IB World School are full diploma candidates.
