CTSO (Career & Technical Student Organizations) Community Service & Competitions for 2020-21

- Plano ISD CTE students logged over 120 hours in community service projects!
- Over 120 Plano ISD CTE students advanced to State level competitions in BPA, DECA, FFA, HOSA, and Computer Science.
- 265 entries in Agricultural Sciences/FFA competitions at various levels.
- 20 Plano ISD CTE students advanced to National/International level competitions in BPA, DECA, and
- 3 Computer Science students were named as National Cyber Scholars.
- Female CS students competed at Digital Divas 2021, an all-girls Texas programming contest, where one team of three students won 1st place as the top Texas Never-Competed-Before Division.
- CS students from all three senior high schools competed at HP Code Wars (a Texas wide event), with one team of three students placing 1st in the novice division.
