Priority 1: 1.1 Improve, align and remove barriers for academic programs to ensure they are accessible to and differentiated for all students to achieve high levels of learning.

Goal 1: By the end of the 2024-2025 school year, the Barksdale staff will improve its system of providing intervention and enrichment through intentional planning that utilizes data to inform instructional decisions and small group instruction.

Performance Target: K-5 READING LANGUAGE ARTS

HB#3 - The percent of 3rd grade students that score Meets grade level or above on STAAR Reading will increase from 79% in 2022 to 81% by June 2025. The Special Education student group performance will increase from 50% in 2022 to 60% by June 2025. The Economically Disadvantaged student group performance will increase from 56% in 2022 to 62% by 2025.

The percent of 4th grade students that score Meets grade level or above on STAAR Reading will increase from 85% in 2022 to 87% by June 2025. The Special Education student group performance will increase from 57% in 2022 to 67% by June 2025. The Economically Disadvantaged student group performance will increase from 67% in 2022 to 73% by 2025.

The percent of 5th grade students that score Meets grade level or above on STAAR Reading will increase from 86% in 2022 to 88% by June 2025. The Special Education student group performance will increase from 45% in 2022 to 55% by June 2025. The Economically Disadvantaged student group performance will increase from 75% in 2022 to 81% by 2025.

Expected Result: Improved planning process as measured by refined data sets and grade level I&E plans resulting in an increase in student performance and closing the achievement gaps of students not meeting grade level standards on STAAR, MAP, and TELPAS.

Expected Result: Improved teacher effectiveness in utilizing the SIOP strategies and intentional planning will lead to increased engagement of Emergent Bilingual students, reducing performance gaps on MAP, STAAR, and TELPAS, and increased overall achievement.

Goal 1: By the end of the 2024-2025 school year, Barksdale Elementary will utilize the PBIS Foundations Team to develop solutions and develop a problem solving process that refines campus systems of behavior management.

Performance Target: Decrease in behavior incidents, increase in positive student behavior and engagement, refined campus systems of behavior management.

Expected Result: The Barksdale staff will be better equipped to respond to behavioral challenges in common areas and the classroom. Additionally, the Foundations Team will have a refined problem solving process to address student behavioral challenges.
