**Priority 1:** Develop and deliver systems for learning that articulate expectations and provide support for all campus instructional leaders and staff that ensures engaging, relevant, and high levels of learning for all students.

**Goal 1:** By the end of the 2024-2025 school year, the campus will strengthen and implement, with fidelity, the components of the collaborative team framework within the grade level planning and professional learning communities.

**Performance Target:** The percent of students that score Meets grade level or above on STAAR Reading and Math will increase from 72% in 2024 to 82% by June 2025. **Expected Result:** Teacher effectiveness will improve in instructional planning, design, and delivery of quality Tier I instruction

**Goal 2:** By the end of the 2024-2025 school year, the campus will strengthen and implement, with fidelity, the components of the collaborative team framework within the grade level planning and professional learning communities.

Performance Target: The percent of students that score Masters grade level on STAAR Reading and Math will increase from 36% in 2024 to 46% by June 2025.

Expected Result: Teacher effectiveness will improve in instructional planning, design, and delivery of quality Tier I instruction

**Priority 2:** Implement, with fidelity, systems and processes to develop consistent practices to use data to inform curriculum, instruction, and assessment decisions specifically to determine interventions and extensions for all students.

**Goal 1:** By the end of the 2024-205 school year, teachers will enhance Targeted instruction by implementing high-yield intervention and enrichment strategies.

Performance Target: The percent of students that score Approaches grade level on STAAR Reading and Math will decrease from 57% in 2024 to 47% by June 2025.

**Expected Result:** Teacher effectiveness and monitoring will improve in planning, design, and delivery of high yield instructional strategies so that gaps in student performance on MAP and STAAR will decrease and overall student achievement will increase.

**Goal 2:** By the end of the 2024-205 school year, teachers will enhance Targeted instruction by implementing high-yield intervention and enrichment strategies.

Performance Target: The percent of students that score Did Not Meet grade level on STAAR Reading and Math will decrease from 70% in 2024 to 60% by June 2025.

**Expected Result:** Teacher effectiveness and monitoring will improve in planning, design, and delivery of high yield instructional strategies so that gaps in student performance on MAP and STAAR will decrease and overall student achievement will increase.

**Priority 3:** By the end of the 2024-2025 school year, the campus will provide a safe and welcoming environment for students, staff and families to experience a sense of belonging.

**Goal 1:** By the end of the 2024-25 school year, staff will implement, with fidelity, interventions and systems of support to ensure a safe, orderly and respectful learning environment.

**Performance Target:** The campus will increase the overall Attendance rate from 95.07% to 96%.

Expected Result: To support student academic achievement, the campus will incorporate effective PBIS strategies to improve student attendance and behavior.

**Goal 2:** By the end of the 2024-25 school year, staff will implement, with fidelity, interventions and systems of support to ensure a safe, orderly and respectful learning environment.

**Performance Target:** The campus will incorporate MTSS strategies to reduce the number of discipline referrals and maintain a disproportionality risk ratio of 2.0 or lower for African American, Special Education, Economically Disadvantaged and Hispanic students.

**Expected Result:** To support student academic achievement, the campus will effectively use the MTSS Behavior Support and Intervention framework to develop and implement high yield intervention strategies to support students' social and emotional needs.
