# **Priorities**

Priority 1: 1.4 Design student experiences to increase student agency and engagement in and out of the classroom.

**Goal 1:** Increase teacher capacity in utilizing structured reading routines, hands-on activities, and critical thinking skills to increase the percent of students who achieve approaches and meets level on Science STAAR in Spanish and English.

Performance Target: The number of students achieving approaches and meets on Science STAAR will increase to 55% Approaches and 15% Meets by Spring 2025.

**Expected Result:** As a result of this goal we will see a change in teacher practice which includes structured reading routines, increase in hands-on opportunities and a greater emphasis on student's ability to think critically.

**Goal 2:** Improve the reading proficiency of 3rd grade students in Spanish by providing engaging instructional strategies that foster critical thinking and comprehension skills.

**Performance Target:** The number of students achieving approaches and meets on Reading-Spanish STAAR will increase to 25% Approaches and 10% Meets by Spring 2025.

**Expected Result:** By implementing a structured deep reading routine, we expect to significantly enhance students' comprehension and critical thinking skills, allowing them to engage deeply with texts.

**Goal 3:** Increase teachers capacity to enhance the math proficiency of 3rd grade students in Spanish by implementing targeted instructional strategies that improve vocabulary and comprehension.

**Performance Target:** The number of students achieving approaches and meets on Math-Spanish STAAR will increase to 60% Approaches and 20% Meets by Spring 2025.

**Expected Result:** By implementing structured student conversation opportunities and enhancing vocabulary through classroom word walls, we expect to improve students' understanding of math concepts significantly. With the integration of academic language through sentence stems, students will become more proficient in articulating their mathematical reasoning.

Goal 4: Building a campus wide system to improve the math proficiency of students in Spanish by enhancing fact fluency.

Performance Target: The number of students achieving approaches and meets on Math State Testing will increase to 40% Approaches and 25% Meets by Spring 2025.

**Expected Result:** By incorporating fact fluency practice into our daily routine and establishing dedicated math centers, we expect to see significant improvements in students' mathematical skills.

#### Priority 2: 4.2 Implement interventions and systems of support to ensure a safe, orderly, and respectful learning environment.

Goal 1: Implement a school wide system to reduce classroom discipline incidents by fostering a consistent and positive behavioral environment.

Performance Target: By the end of May 2025, we will reduce the percentage of discipline incidents occurring in the classroom from 48.9% to 36.7%.

**Expected Result:** By establishing and consistently reinforcing clear behavioral expectations, we expect to create a more positive classroom environment that minimizes discipline incidents.
